How this test is administered

A Supervisor's Script containing everything heard by the candidate on the CD is included in this booklet. As Supervisor, you **must** study this material carefully whilst playing through the CD **before** the examination begins.

There are three parts to the test and each part will be heard **twice**.

Remember to press the 'pause' button and not the 'stop' button on the CD player when a pause is indicated in the script (*). If the 'stop' button is pressed, the CD will return to the start of track 1.

Parts One, Two, and Three:

- Pause the CD **before** each of Parts One, Two, and Three of the test to give the candidate adequate time to read through the questions. An asterisk (*) in the Script will remind you when to do this.
- Each extract in the sequence of extracts for each part is immediately repeated. Pause the CD after each hearing. An asterisk (*) in the Script will remind you when to do this.
- Pause the CD **after** each part to give the candidate adequate time to check his/her answers. An asterisk (*) in the Script will remind you when to do this.

The lengths of pauses are at your discretion. However, please ensure candidates have sufficient time to read questions or write their answers.

Do not replay any part of the CD.

The correct question number must be written beside each answer.

[MUSIC]

Part One.

Questions 1 – 5.

Pat and Miss Box are speaking about a photo.

Read sentences A – G ☼

Now listen and choose the correct sentence for the people 1 – 5. ☼

There is one example about Pat. Listen to the example.

- 1 Here's a photo of me and my friends in the park, Miss Box.
2 Oh yes! Who's that? The boy with the cats?
1 His name's Pat. He's holding one cat in his arms! Pat loves animals.
2 That's good. ☼

The answer is 'A'. This is an example. ☼

Now you listen and write.

Note to supervisors: Each extract is immediately repeated. Pause after <u>each</u> hearing.
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One

- 1 There's a girl here, too. She's behind the pear tree!
2 Yes. She's funny. Her name's Lucy.
1 And what's Lucy doing behind that tree?
2 Sorry! I don't know. Playing a game? ☼

Now listen again.

[EXTRACT ONE IS REPEATED] ☼

Two

- 1 And there's Jill. She's got some bread in her hand.
2 Is she giving it to the ducks?
1 Yes! Jill loves ducks.
2 Me too! ☼

Now listen again.

[EXTRACT TWO IS REPEATED] ☼

Three

- 1 That's a great kite!
2 Yes, that's Dan's kite.
1 Is Dan the boy in the red T-shirt?
2 Yes, that's right. ❀

Now listen again.

[EXTRACT THREE IS REPEATED] ❀

Four

- 1 One person is reading. What's her name?
2 The girl with the book?
1 Yes.
2 That's my friend Ann. Reading is Ann's favourite hobby. ❀

Now listen again.

[EXTRACT FOUR IS REPEATED] ❀

Five

- 1 And what's that boy's name? The boy on the bike.
2 That's Nick. Nick's in my class at school.
1 Oh! He's got a nice bike!
2 I know! It's new. He loves it. ❀

Now listen again.

[EXTRACT FIVE IS REPEATED] ❀

Now read your answers again. ❀

That is the end of Part One.

Part Two.

A boy is talking to a man in a shop. Read questions 6 – 10. ❀

There are two examples. Read the examples. ❀

Now listen to the examples.

- 1 Hello.
2 Hello. I want some new football shirts for my school, please.
1 OK. What's the name of your school?
2 It's Hall Street School.
1 H-A-L-L?
2 That's right. Hall Street School. It's new. ❀
- 1 And how many shirts do you want?
2 Twelve, please.
1 Twelve. That's a lot.
2 They're for my class. ❀

The answers to the examples are 'Hall' and '12'. ☼

Now you listen and write a name or a number.

Note to supervisors: Each extract is immediately repeated. Pause after each hearing.

Six

- 1 Do you want small shirts or big shirts?
2 I'd like eleven small shirts, please.
1 Eleven?
2 Yes, please. ☼

Now listen again.

[EXTRACT SIX IS REPEATED] ☼

Seven

- 1 And I'd like one big shirt for our teacher, please.
2 Oh, yes. What's your teacher's name?
1 It's Mr Cross.
2 Is that C-R-O-S-S?
1 Yes, that's right. Mr Cross is our sports teacher. ☼

Now listen again.

[EXTRACT SEVEN IS REPEATED] ☼

Eight

- 1 And which class are you in?
2 I'm in Class 8.
1 Class 8?
2 Yes. ☼

Now listen again.

[EXTRACT EIGHT IS REPEATED] ☼

Nine

- 1 And what's your name?
2 It's Ben. That's B-E-N.
1 Thank you, Ben.
2 OK. ☼

Now listen again.

[EXTRACT NINE IS REPEATED] ☼

Ten

- 1 And where do you live?
2 I live in White Street.
1 White Street? W-H-I-T-E?
2 That's right.
1 Thank you. ☼

Now listen again.

[EXTRACT TEN IS REPEATED] ☼

Now read your answers again. ☼

That is the end of Part Two.

Part Three. Questions 11 – 15.

Listen and write A, B or C.

There is one example. Read the example. ☼

Now listen to the example.

What is Pat doing?

- 1 Is Pat at your house?
2 Yes, she is.
1 Is she playing in the garden?
2 No. She's reading in the living room. ☼

The answer is C. Pat is reading. ☼

Now read questions 11 – 15. ☼

Now listen and write A, B or C.

Note to supervisors: Each extract is immediately repeated. Pause after each hearing.

Eleven. Which is May?

- 1 Where's May, Mum?
2 Is that her, wearing trousers?
1 No, she's wearing a skirt.
2 Oh yes and a T-shirt. She looks great! ☼

Now listen again.

[EXTRACT ELEVEN IS REPEATED] ☼

Twelve. Which is Nick's favourite ice-cream?

- 1 Is that an apple ice-cream, Nick?
2 No, it's pineapple.
1 Is that your favourite?
2 No. My favourite's banana. ❄

Now listen again.

[EXTRACT TWELVE IS REPEATED] ❄

Thirteen. What is Ben doing?

- 1 Is Ben on the beach?
2 Yes. He's with his friends.
1 Are they swimming?
2 No, they're kicking a ball. ❄

Now listen again.

[EXTRACT THIRTEEN IS REPEATED] ❄

Fourteen. Where is Kim's doll?

- 1 Why are you sad, Kim?
2 I can't find my doll.
1 Is it in the toy box?
2 No! Oh look. I can see it. It's behind the chair. ❄

Now listen again.

[EXTRACT FOURTEEN IS REPEATED] ❄

Fifteen. What is Dad doing?

- 1 Is Dad in the bedroom?
2 No, he's in the bathroom.
1 Oh yes, he's listening to the radio.
2 No, he's singing. That's nice. ❄

Now listen again.

[EXTRACT FIFTEEN IS REPEATED] ❄

Now read your answers again. ❄

That is the end of Part Three.
